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BOOSTING CHILDREN'S RESILIENCE, SELF-ESTEEM, & EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE THROUGH DRAMA.



The Bounce Drama Project is a drama and PSHE project for children in Year 3 and 4. In weekly Bounce Drama Project sessions, the children watch a short film excerpt where our character Freddie the Frog presents a challenge. The children then take on the role of the expert and use drama and role play to develop their problem-solving skills. We aim to build a toolbox of skills such as communicating feelings, emotional intelligence, understanding the zones of regulation and building healthy habits.

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The Bounce Project has **three distinct units** which support the PSHE curriculum:

ALL ABOUT ME

This unit focuses on the children gaining understanding of themselves, what makes them unique and how they can help themselves and others to feel confident and celebrated.

Topics covered: Self-esteem, self-confidence, our thoughts, friendships and bullying.



EMOTIONS

We discuss the emotions that they might feel in daily life as well as develop skills and techniques to self regulate using the Zones of Regulation.

Topics covered: What are Emotions? Zones of Regulation. Dealing with uncomfortable emotions.

HAPPY HEALTHY HABITS

This unit helps the children to understand the foundations of living a healthy life.

Topics covered: Healthy eating, sleep, exercise and mental health and emotional wellbeing.
